An environmental evaluation is being prepared for proposed development at the Mason City Municipal Airport subject to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). The NEPA review process requires compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), as implemented through 36 CFR 800. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is the lead federal agency for the NEPA document.

The intent of this letter is to request your input on properties of cultural or religious significance that may be affected by the proposed undertaking and invite you to participate in the Section 106 consultation process.

The proposed undertaking includes the following proposed projects:

- Construct new terminal building either immediately west or south of the existing terminal
- Construct associated aircraft apron, circulation roads, and parking lots
- Demolish existing terminal building

Federal funding was made available to the airport under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. The airport has until May 10, 2024 to utilize the funds. To allow time for construction, it is proposed that the project will be bid in June 2022 with construction starting in the fall, providing 18 months to complete the project.

To help in our preparation of the EA, we would appreciate your input (via mail or e-mail) within thirty (30) days. Jim Johnson, FAA Central Region Airports Division Manager, will be making the final FAA decision. 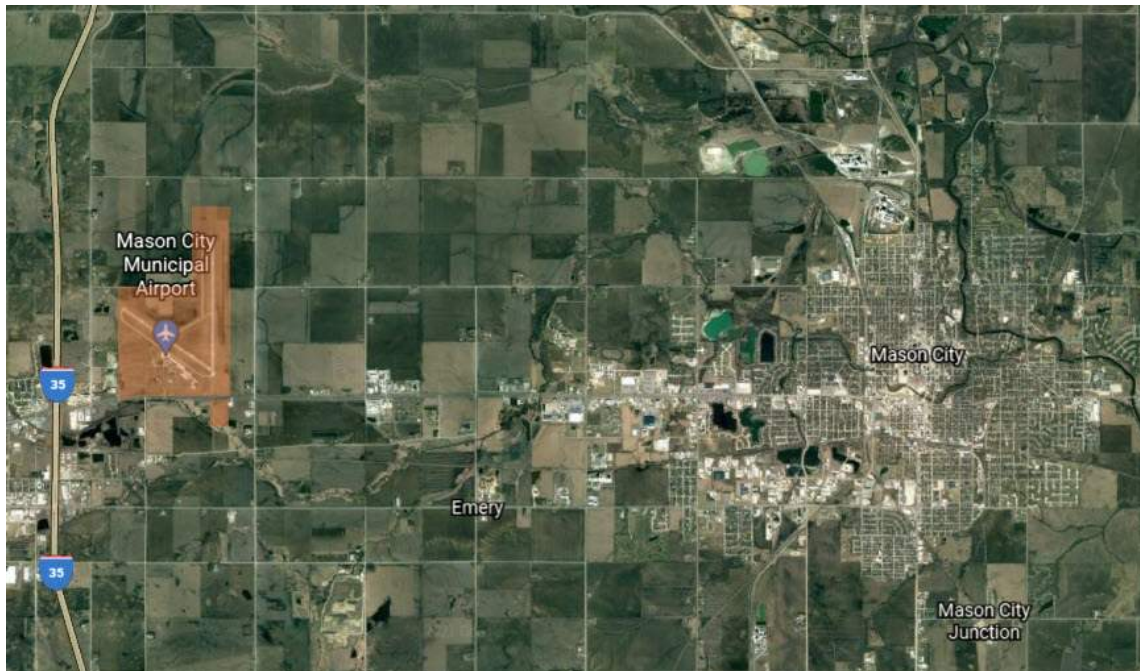
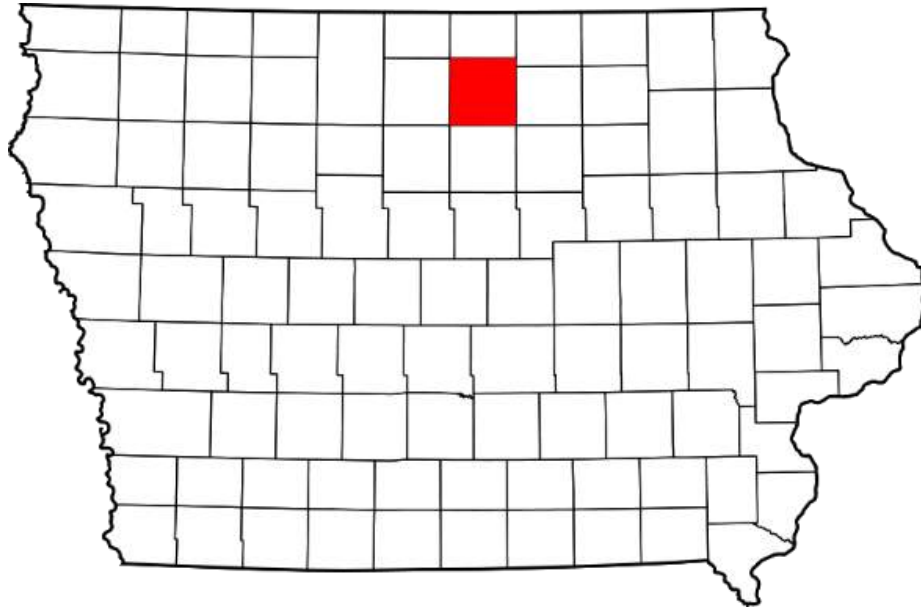


FIGURE 1 LOCATION and Vicinity Map

FIGURE 4 POTENTIAL AREA OF IMPACT (NEW TERMINAL)

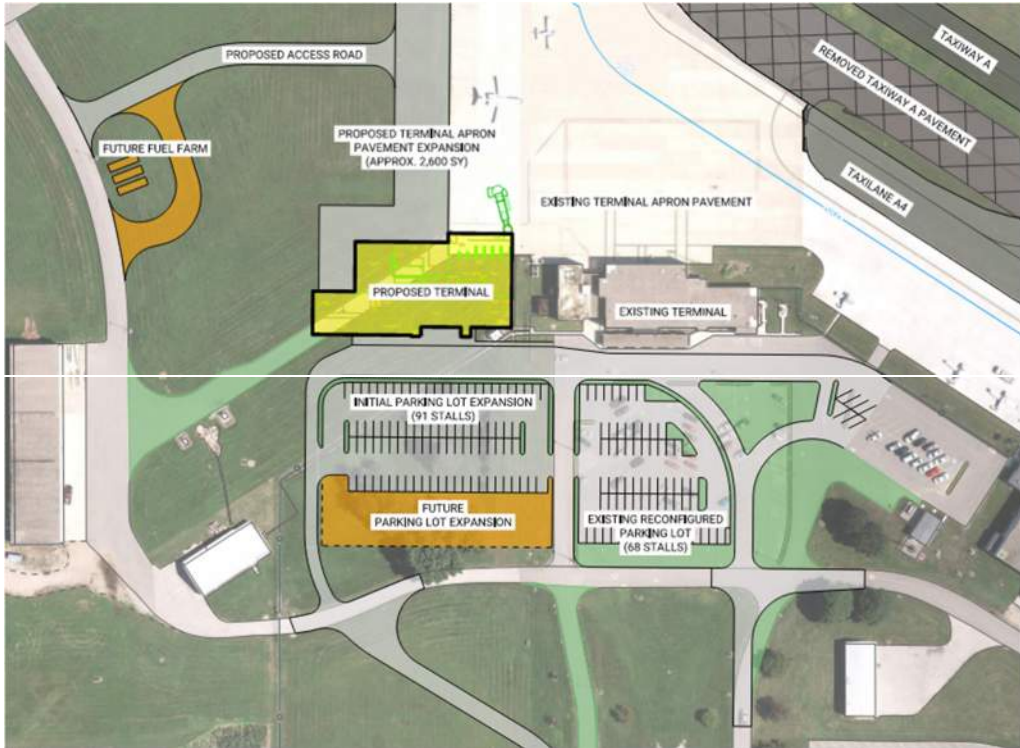


FIGURE 5 POTENTIAL WEST TERMINAL, PARKING, AND ACCESS ROAD

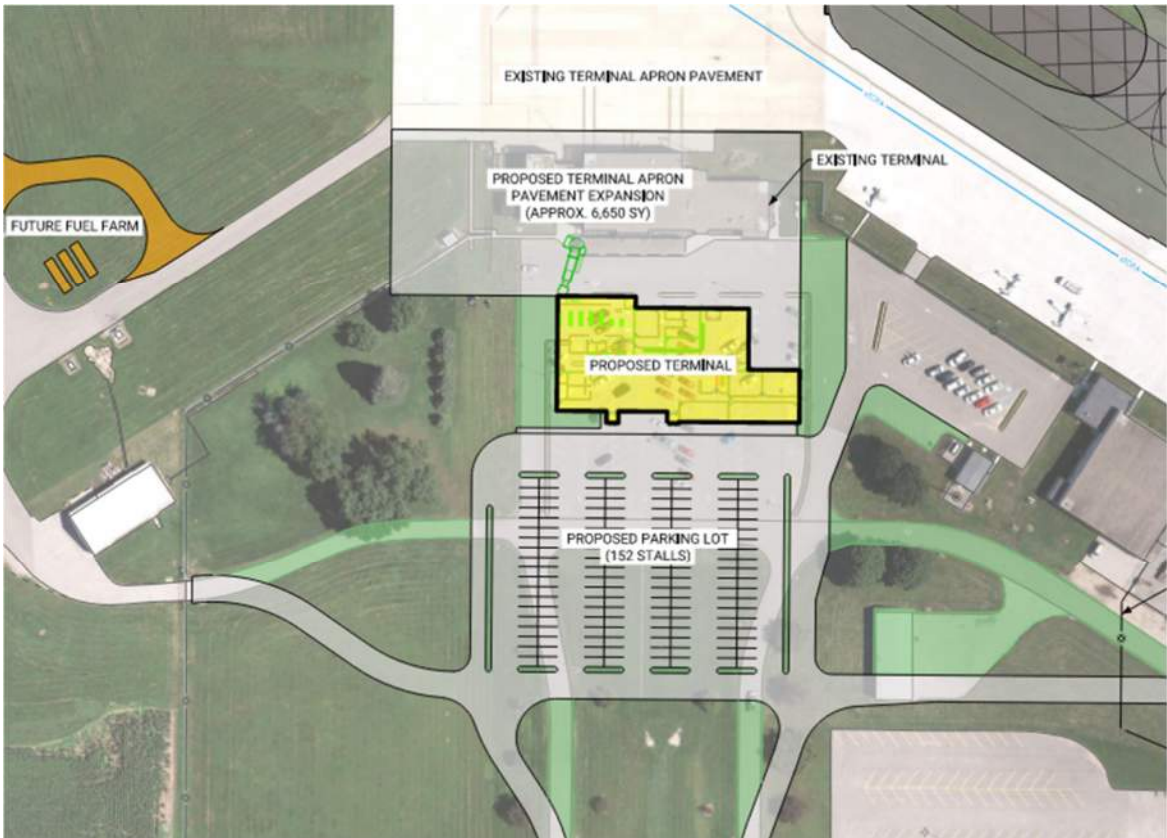


FIGURE 6 POTENTIAL SOUTH TERMINAL, PARKING, AND ACCESS ROAD
